It's time for the 15th annual New Braunfels' Wein and Saengerfest!

A unique heritage festival blended with old, but familiar traditions. Held in charming, historic downtown New Braunfels, near the banks of the Comal River, this festival has something for everyone!

Wineries from throughout Texas will be invited to participate in a wine tasting event along with musicians performing throughout the day and into the evening until 10PM.

Other special events include a Grape Stomp, Weinstein University (*wine related informational seminars*), craft beer tasting, food and beverage booths, farmers market, and family activities.

Arts and Crafts Vendor Information – Juried Show
Vendor Responsibilities

Eligibility: You must be an artist or a craftsperson presenting original works.

- Demonstrating your art or craft, while not required, is considered desirable.
- **NO** import items, mass-produced items, direct sales or information booths allowed.
- To maintain the quality and balance of the arts and crafts shown, this is a juried show. A qualified panel of people will judge the photographs you present for consideration. Please be sure to submit clear pictures that accurately portray your work. Not all entries are guaranteed to be accepted.

Location: Downtown New Braunfels

Date: Saturday, May 5th

Hours of Operation: Noon to 8:00 p.m.

Booths must be opened and manned during hours of operation

Move-in: Saturday, May 5th Staggered by booth location, beginning at 9:00 AM¹
No early entry into festival grounds is allowed. Violations will be grounds for rejection of future entry applications.

Move-out: Saturday, May 6th 8:00 PM
No tear-down may begin before 7:45 PM. Vehicles are not allowed to enter the festival grounds before 8:00 PM and MUST follow move-out directions. Violations will be grounds for rejection of future entry applications.

Booth space: Booth space assignment will be completed after the jury results are finished. The assignment requests will be accommodated based upon the receipt date of a complete application with all required attachments and payments.

- 10' x 10' or 10' x 20' open spaces are provided.
- Vendors may enhance their booth's visual appeal with an encroachment into the festival walkway with décor or items for sale at a maximum depth of 2-1/2-foot and a maximum 50% of the width of the booth space encumbered with said items.
- You must provide all of your own display equipment, i.e. tables, chairs, canopy or tent, skirts, etc.
- Canopy corners must be secured by weights, as canopies will be located on a paved roadway.
- All tables must be covered and skirted.
- **NO Electricity** available. Silent generators may be approved; details and specifications must be submitted with the application. Subject to Fire Department review and consideration. **No gas generators are allowed.**
- Extension cords associated with silent generators must be taped down.

Registration: All registration forms must be completed and accompanied by:

- a minimum of 4 photographs – your photographs will be kept on file and will not be returned.

¹ Line up order, route and instructions will be forwarded to vendor with booth and parking assignments.

- a check, payable to the City of New Braunfels or credit card information. Your payment will not be processed until you have been accepted into the show, and your check will be shredded (or your credit card not charged, if you have provided us with this form of payment) if you are not accepted.
- **The deadline for application is March 12th, 2018.** There are a limited number of spaces. Please apply early!

Space Fees:

- \$85 for a 10' x 10' space
- \$140 for a 10' x 20' space
- \$25 additional for corner space, **per** corner (example: 10'x20', 2 corners = \$190)

Notification of

Acceptance: You will be notified of your acceptance no later than March 30th, 2018. Please note: there will be no refunds after acceptance and no refunds should bad weather or illness occur.

IF accepted, booth assignment and instructions will be emailed to you by April 27th.

Food or drink: All vendors **providing** drink or food to the general public (sampling or otherwise served) are required to obtain a **Temporary Food Permit** application. There **MAY NOT** be a fee for the health permit depending on what is occurring. The Health Division does need to know how you will serve and/or conduct food/drink sampling. Deadline for a temporary health permit is April 30, 2018. No late submittals allowed.

Parking: Assigned parking will be provided to all participants with space assignment number and move-in/move-out instructions.

Clean up: Vendors are responsible for cleaning up their display areas. Proper trash removal is respectfully requested and extra dumpsters will be provided behind the 200 Block of W. San Antonio Street.

Port-a-potties: Will be located throughout the Marktplatz, as well as other locations in the historic downtown district.

Event Security: Will be located throughout the historic downtown district; however, we will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.

Behavior: Vendors are the "face and voice" of the event and we ask that you be Great Ambassadors along with the other event participants. Thanks in advance for your help to ensure all guests and vendors have a pleasant experience!

Refunds: The City of New Braunfels will not issue refunds for cancellations.
